Application Due Date: February 28, 2022

Purpose: The THS Foundation Classroom Grants program provides funding to support innovative ideas and projects at the classroom level. Projects should provide promising educational experiences that support student learning. Grants may be used to purchase tangible materials or fund field trips, but may not fund items or activities traditionally provided by the school district.

Application Procedure: Complete Section A on this form. Please submit all information requested in Sections B in the order listed and no more than two pages in length. **Include a copy of the estimated cost for all items, along with shipping, handling, and any installation charges.** Signatures of a key contact teacher submitting the grant and the building principal are required. All applications must be reviewed by the Superintendent prior to submission to the THS Foundation.

Grants Deadline: Applications should be received by the Foundation on or before February 28, 2022. Late applications will not be considered. Grants will be awarded before the end of the current school year.
