



## Best Tips for Completing the Tekamah Herman Foundation Scholarships

1. Prepare a resume before starting applications
2. Transcripts
  - College Students** - Order your transcript from your college before starting applications
  - High School Students**- Have your transcript ready to upload
3. Letter of Acceptance **\*\*HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS ONLY**
  - High School Students** - Have your letter of acceptance ready to upload
4. **Prepare your answers to these questions (they will be asked more than once):**
  - Why do you think you should be awarded a scholarship from the Tekamah-Herman Foundation?
  - Have there been any circumstances that have affected your academic performance? (Illness in your family, divorce, financial problems, etc.)?
  - If you do not receive scholarships, how will you finance your education?
  - High School Students - In your view what is the greatest accomplishment you have achieved during your High School Career? Alumni - In your view what is the greatest accomplishment you have achieved after your high school career?
  - What do you see as your most important goal in your post-secondary educational career?
  - Describe the person or persons who have had the greatest impact on your life and why.
  - List community and school organizations you are involved with.
5. Have all applications completed by April 15th by midnight. Anything submitted after that deadline will not be accepted.
6. Pay attention to the eligibility requirements. If you do not meet the GPA requirement, it will not be accepted. Also, do not apply to scholarships that you are ineligible for (i.e Alumni applying for high school senior only scholarships).
